## ANNEXE 1: Residence and nationality eligibility criteria for an EMJMD scholarship [applicable to applicants for Erasmus Mundus scholarship]

a-Nationality: applicants must belong to one of these categories:

- Programme country students: "students whose nationality is one of the Erasmus+ Programme Countries count as Programme Country students."

  The programme countries are the one as defined in the Erasmus+ programme guide (Page 21)
- 2- **Partner country students:** "students whose nationality is one of the Erasmus+ Partner Countries and are not residents nor have carried out their main activity (studies, training or work) for more than a total of 12 months over the last five years<sup>1</sup> in any Programme Country are considered as Partner Country students." The partner countries are the one as defined in the <u>Erasmus+ programme guide</u> (Pages 21-22-23)

b- Place of residence: applicants should be resident of a programme or partner country (and provide at least one certificate of residence<sup>2</sup>):

- 1- **Resident of a programme country**: the programme countries are the ones defined in the <u>Erasmus+ programme</u> guide (Page 21)
- 2- **Resident of a partner country:** the partner countries are the ones defined in the <u>Erasmus+ programme guide</u> (Pages 21-22-23)
